# Why Cite?

We add quotations in our own writing to support the statements we are making.

Quotes from other sources make our writing **stronger**.

## **Remember R.A.C.E.S.?**

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The third step in R.A.C.E.S. is to “cite” or provide a quotation from the reading to support your point.

First, you will need to choose a quote that supports the point you are making.



## How To Add Quotations in R.A.C.E.S. Responses

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After **RESTATING** and **ANSWERING** the question, you will include your quote.

You **must** first introduce the quote.

## **For example...**

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According to the article...

The author of the article indicates...

The reading states....

The author says...

## **How To Add Quotations in R.A.C.E.S. Responses**

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Be sure to use a comma after your introduction of the quote.

Use quotation marks around the words from the quote.



# RECAP!

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## First:

Choose a quote that supports the point you are making.

## Second:

Introduce the quote with a statement like “According to the article.”

## Third:

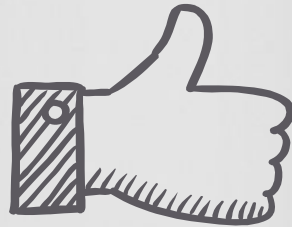
Use a comma after introducing the quote.

## Fourth:

Make sure you include double quotation marks.

## Fifth:

Move on to the next step!
