## Setting

#### What is setting?

- Refers to the place or type of surroundings where an event takes place.
- It provides a time and a place for the story to take place.
- The definition can include social status, weather, historical periods and details about the immediate surrounding.
- Helps to contribute to the atmosphere in a story.
- Most stories have more than one setting.

#### Significance of Setting in Literature

- Setting can have a huge impact on the characters.
- Most plot lines are closely tied to their setting and thus could not be put in other places, time periods or environments.





### **Imagery**

This is when the author uses words and phrases to create mental images for the reader.

It helps the reader to visualize what the author is writing about.

# Simile and Metaphor

Both simile and metaphor can be used as a part of imagery, in order to help the reader visualize exactly what the author is writing about.

#### Simile

A comparison between two unrelated things which uses the words "as" or "like". Authors make these comparisons to create a greater understanding.

## Metaphor

A direct comparison between two things which allows the reader to see the similarities and shared traits.

Ex: "Henry was a lion on the battlefield".
